

Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP)

If you're needing assistance with everyday tasks and feel that a little support could improve your health and wellbeing, then the government-funded Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) could be right for you.

CHSP helps senior Australians access entry-level support so that you can live independently and safely at home.

We can help with ongoing services such as in-home personal care and domestic assistance, community access and social support. Plus, we can even help you to access to higher intensity support for a shorter term, such as respite for carers.

How do I access CHSP?

The first step is to get in touch and we can help you get started. My Aged Care will organise the Regional Assessment Service (RAS) to talk to you about your needs and assess your eligibility.

Generally speaking, if you're an older person having trouble managing everyday tasks and activities, you are eligible for the program.

What services can I arrange?

Lots of helpful services to help keep you happy, healthy and independent. We can support you with:

- Personal care (showering, dressing etc.)
- Domestic assistance and household tasks
- Respite
- Shopping, community access and social activities
- Meal preparation.

What's the difference between CHSP and a Home Care Package (HCP)?

Both programmes are designed to help support you at home. CHSP offers services at a basic level of care and has a lower level of funding. A HCP offers a significantly larger amount of funding – up to around \$50,000 per year, and is delivered to meet the needs of people with higher care needs.

Many people start off with CHSP services while they wait for their HCP to be approved – a great way to stay at home for longer without the need for full-time care.
